Action Item: Support/Not Support the proposed planning area boundary change between College Area and Kensington-Talmadge. This action will conclude a process begun August 10, 2016 when the planning group approved a resolution to begin discussions on a boundary change with the College Area. The proposal would recommend to the City a change to the eastern and northeastern planning area boundary from its current location on the ridge crest on the south side of Montezuma Road, northward to the road centerline, and from the ridge crest between 51st St/Contour Drive and Collwood Boulevard, eastward to the Collwood Boulevard centerline, as well as eastward to the centerline of the intersection at 54th St and El Cajon Boulevard at the very south east of the planning area.
